### Report on Actions from meeting dated 17/12/2024.

24/177 The SID has come back after being maintained by Westcotec. We also have a new battery for it. One of the criteria is to have evidence of a speeding problem which must be measurable data, for example from community speedwatch monitoring, not just personal perception.
