25/20	To approve the minutes of the meeting held on 18 th March 2025. These were approved and signed.	
25/21	To receive the Snowdrop Valley Budget for 2025/26. This was received by the committee.	
25/22	Confirm dates of the 2026 and 2027 event for the road closure, to include a five-week window in case of bad weather. It was agreed to keep the dates to a four-week window rather than five weeks between 24 th Jan 2026 – 22 nd February 2026 and 23rd Jan 2027 – 21st Feb 2027.	
25/23	Discuss a plan to get more volunteers. The following ideas were suggested:

	- Do a press release to try and encourage interest.	
	- Advertise for volunteers on social media.	
	- Distribute posters and leaflets.	
	 Look into ideas of possible incentives for volunteers. [Cllr Hazel Crockford joined the meeting] 	
	- Advertise in the parish magazine.	
	 Encourage people in the wording to 'bring a friend' and highlight about it being a social opportunity. 	
25/24	Discuss ideas for a merchandise display. It would be ideal to have a slanted clear covered box to put the merchandise in, and so people can see it without it blowing away. The clerk will investigate what is available along with prices and will bring to the next meeting.	Clerk
25/25	Discuss ideas for more advertising/flyers in local hotels, pubs, and B&B's. The Clerk will put together some A5 leaflets ready to get them in local hotels etc by winter ready for the people who are coming to visit during Christmas.	
25/26	Discuss advertising. An advertisement is going out in the Winter edition of Exmoor Magazine which will be out in October. It was agreed not to go ahead with advertising in the Spring edition as it would be too late. Cally is in the process of updating Visit Exmoor with the dates for 2026 and she will also use them to help with the search for volunteers.	

25/27	To receive information of the launch of Snowdrop Gardens Trail. The Snowdrop Gardens Trail will start to promote all the Snowdrop Gardens across Somerset for 2026. There will be a dedicated website for it. Cally has submitted copy and images for it. We will share the Somerset Snowdrop Trail logo on signs at the Snowdrop Valley event to show people we are officially part of the trail. There is no cost for being involved in this project and it is great for joint PR. We will emphasise that ours are the original and natural Snowdrops planted by the Benedictine monks. Committee members will try and gain as much information about the history of how the Snowdrops originated and the Benedictine monks who planted them.
